## Update on the Implementation date for mandatory conformity assessment for radio and telecom equipment in Belarus.

Further to PCS Regulatory Update dated 31st October 2016, it has been advised that further changes to Decree 849 of 21st October 2016 have been made and that as such the implementation date for mandatory national level conformity assessment for certain radio/telecom devices has been changed.

The implementation date for mandatory national level conformity assessment for the below product categories will be pushed out to 1<sup>st</sup> May 2017:

- 10.7. Telephone receivers of all types, coin telephones and other appliances, which can be connected to subscriber loops, and functioning via dialling number and transmitting and receiving voice messages
- 10.8. <u>Document electric communication terminals</u>, including those incorporated in any other equipment, fax machines, fax boards
- III. <u>10.12. End-user terminals for mobile cell systems</u> including radio modules incorporated in other equipment
- IV. 10.14. Radio equipment of DECT standard, including radio modules incorporated in other devices
- V. <u>10.15. Broadband wireless access equipment</u>, including radio modules incorporated in other equipment

For all other product categories, mandatory Approval will still be required from 1st February 2017.

Please note that the official government decision is expected to be signed within coming weeks, after which PCS will advise accordingly.

PCS will continue to monitor this change, and will keep customers updated once more information becomes available.
